Dear Mr. Sherman:

This is in response to your January 24, 2000, request for Federal Aviation Administration authorization to identify Parachute Models originally approved in a January 31, 1984, TSO authorization by part number. This letter does not change the effective date of your original approval; simply identifies part numbers in lieu of the component names of the original approval. Further, this letter has no effect on your ability to assure compliance with 14 CFR, part 21, subpart O, including 14 CFR, part 21.143.

Your original Statement of Conformance, Quality Control Manual, and data listed in your October 17, 1983, original TSO authorization are acceptable and will still be retained for this authorization.

Effective this date, you are authorized to identify Part Number SSE002 (formerly the SSI/RACER); Part Number SST202 (formerly the Firefly Reserve); Part Number SST100 (formerly SSI Pilotchute); Part Number SST220 (formerly the Square Reserve "D" Bag); and Part Number SST110 (formerly the Racer 26' Reserve), with the appropriate TSO markings required by the applicable TSO and 14 CFR, part 21, subpart 21.607(d).

This authorization is not transferable to another person or location and is effective until surrendered, withdrawn, or otherwise terminated by the Administrator.

Your responsibilities as a holder of a TSO authorization are outlined in 14 CFR, subpart 21.3 and 14 CFR, part 21, subpart O. Any design change made to the TSO'd item must be forwarded to this office as outlined in 14 CFR, part 21.611, with minor change submittal intervals not to exceed six months.
